#### Parking changes:

Following consultation earlier in the year, there have been some changes to parking restrictions in this part of the city. Double yellow lines and residents parking on Long John Hill should make that less of a challenge to negotiate. In our area, 24 hour restrictions have been extended to Southgate Lane, Carrow Hill and Corton Road (now with parking both sides at the Bracondale end, a change we strongly opposed). Onstreet parking restrictions at the top of Bracondale itself seem to be unchanged (8am to 6.30pm only).

#### History Group new book out in December!

The latest Bracondale book is almost ready to go to press – *Bracondale* – *a village within the city* tells the story of some of the past residents of Bracondale who have led notable or interesting lives. The book includes photos from the Jarrold family (who lived at what is now 34 Bracondale) from the early part of the last century, new drawings from Helen Hoyte, and lots more.
